While we highly recommend applying for projects that are stated as priorities below, other worthy initiatives will be considered. *Please be aware that we will not fund projects for more than two consecutive years.* In addition to evaluating whether a project meets our mission and our priorities, the following criteria will be considered: the project 1) addresses a significant community issue; 2) outlines a thoughtful, innovative plan to confront the issue; 3) builds a network of individuals/groups to collaborate on the issue and 4) demonstrates energy and commitment to achieve stated goals.

- Fostering production/sale of local foods
- Fostering sustainable/regenerative farming
- Creating/enhancing farmers' markets
- Creating/enhancing local food systems
- Creating/enhancing agricultural processing facilities
- Transitioning farms to the next generation
- Training farm and/or non-farm labor
- Promoting rural community development initiatives
- Stewarding our sacred land and water
